**Specialized Needs:** Volunteers need to have varying degrees of experience and ability and will need to attend orientation in order to help in these areas. Please consider the commitment needed for these opportunities.

- Stage Hands: moving microphones and props used during all general sessions. May require meeting during the day as per the Stage Manager's direction.
- Stage Manager's Assistant: assists during & before all General Sessions; will need to attend meetings during the day per the Stage Mgr.
- Information table assistants (2 people): to help man the information table throughout the week. Person will spend time learning procedures & policies.
- Hospitality Room Assistant: to help the conference hospitality coordinator service several special rooms.
- Special Interest Group (SIG) assistant: to help monitor SIGs and update SIG locations and meeting times.
- CA Tapes Recording Assistant: to help our recording company with recordings & sales booth setup and teardown.
- Power Point/Tech Assistant (2 people): assist slide preparation; operating slides & videos for the Sessions
- Production Editor: help organize video & images for Saturday night's session. Knowledge & experience in working with a video camera/editing equipment is **required**.
- Office Assistants: Help with administrative duties: copies, errands, etc. throughout the week.
- ASL Licensed Interpreters: We need two to three ASL Interpreters to be available throughout the week to attend meetings with our hearing impaired guests. .

***Exodus Mission Statement: Mobilizing the body of Christ to Minister God's grace and truth to a world impacted by homosexuality.***

**Exodus Doctrinal Statement:** We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are the inspired Word Of God, the final authority for doctrine, reproof, correction, and instruction for right living. We believe in one God, existing eternally in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, fully man and fully God, only begotten Son of the Father. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, and lived a sinless life. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, buried and rose physically from the dead. He ascended to the right hand of the Father and will come again in power and glory.

We believe that faith alone in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord frees us from the mastery of sin, and its consequences of death and eternal damnation. He assumed the penalty of death Himself, and enables us to live out of His resurrected life unto eternity. We believe the Holy Spirit carries out this work of renewal in our lives, empowering us to grow in loving union with our Heavenly Father and to walk in obedience to His will. We believe that the Church of Jesus Christ is formed of all those who know Him as their Savior and Lord, regardless of denominational beliefs.

**Exodus Core Values:**

**1. We believe that the Bible, both Old and New Testaments, is the inerrant, unchangeable, and absolute Word of God; therefore, it is relevant and essential for us today.**

This includes the concept that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and that we are all in need of a Savior who will, by His grace, justify, redeem and restore those who call on His name. Isaiah 40:8, 2 Timothy 3:16-17

**2. We believe that all expressions of sexual intimacy outside the bonds of heterosexual marriage are both unbiblical and immoral.**

This includes the concept that there are no exceptions to this rule. Genesis 2:24, Leviticus 18:22, Mark 10:9, 1 Timothy 3:2, Hebrews 13:4

**3. We believe that homosexuality is primarily a developmental disorder, with spiritual implications, and not limited to genetic or biological factors.**

This includes the concept that homosexuality is not innate, immutable or unchangeable. Those who submit to the Lordship of Christ and a process of healing can attain freedom from the homosexual condition (behaviors, identity, mindset), allowing for growth into heterosexuality. 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, 2 Corinthians 5:17, Philippians 1:6, Matthew 16:24

**4. We believe it is a Biblical mandate to persistently and relentlessly extend the love of Christ to any person that comes our way and that no person is beyond the grace of God or unworthy of our time, love or energy.**

This includes the concepts that the riches of God are found in His kindness, tolerance, and patience, and that it is God's kindness that leads us to repentance. Those who judge others will also be judged. Romans 2:1-4, Mark 12:30-31

**5. We believe that the Biblical model for mentoring is central to our work, and through the relationship between the pastoral care-givers and the individuals struggling with homosexuality, truth can be imparted, grace modeled, and healing realized.**

This includes the concept of practically and supernaturally bridging and repairing the God-child, father-child, mother-child and mother-father relationships via Biblical teaching, wise counsel and one-on-one group relationships. Hebrews 10:23-25, 1 Timothy 1:2, 2 Timothy 1:2, Titus 2:1-8

**6. We believe in speaking the truth in love to the world regarding homosexuality.**

This includes the concept of speaking, teaching and testifying to the truth about homosexuality in boldness, not arrogance, with confidence, not judgment, and with love, not hate. 2 Timothy 2:23-26

**7. We believe that excellence honors God and reflects His character.**

This includes the concepts of evaluation, critical review, quality control, professionalism and being good stewards of the money entrusted to us. Proverbs 27:17, Colossians 3:17, 22-24, Matthew 25:14-30

**8. We believe that leaders should reflect Christ's character in all ways including integrity, honesty, vulnerability, obedience and faithfulness.**

This includes the concepts of character, life modeling and the fruit of the Spirit. 1 Corinthians 11:1, 1 Timothy 3:1-13, Titus 1:6-9, Galatians 5:22-2
